

FINANCIAL HARDSHIP PROGRAM

This financial hardship program is offered to any family facing financial hardship and needs assistance for their child to attend an individual MGBR event. Those who qualify will receive a credit of \$75 towards the Michigan Top 320 Super Showcase (October 3, 2010). To qualify for the financial hardship program applicants must be able to show documentation. Spots are available on a first come first serve basis until the event is full (based on graduating year and position).

Any of the following documentation can be attached to this form in order to qualify.

- ✓ Letter from the student's high school indicating financial hardship
- ✓ Documentation of a legal guardian receiving unemployment within the last 30 days
- ✓ Documentation of a legal guardian receiving any benefits due to financial hardship through the Michigan Department of Human Services.
- ✓ Documentation of the legal guardian receiving any benefits due to financial hardship through the federal government.

**Copies of documentation are sufficient. All documentation must be legible.
